Musical artist and peace activist Ken Koshio will travel with Derrick Suwaima Davis (Hopi/Choctaw), 5-time World Champion Native American Hoop Dance Champion and musical guest Ryon Polequaptewa (Hopi) promoting Prayers for Peace, a movement which emphasizes world peace and harmony for all people and generations to come.

As part of this cultural exchange and movement toward world peace, last May thru June, Hiroshima survivor Keiko Murakami traveled to the United States to share her experience and serve as keynote speaker for Hiroshima Calling (produced by Ken Koshio). Keiko toured the west coast and southwest, visiting the Hopi reservation, museums and other venues presenting her story entitled "How to Make a Peaceful Society." The purpose of this tour is to promote a message of peace and to serve as good will ambassadors for peace and harmony for all people.
